Kindergarten Age Requirement

Students seeking admission to Kindergarten should be 5 years old by the September 1 of the academic year of enrollment. Schaeffer Academy will consider early entrance for students with 5th birthdays between September 1 and 30 who also meet or exceed specific requirements established by Schaeffer Academy. Acceptance and Enrollment

The application document and fee enable the work necessary to determine whether a student is a good fit for Schaeffer Academy. When all of the admission materials (see Admission Requirements) have been received and reviewed, the student and parents will be scheduled for an interview with the headmaster. Following that interview, they will be notified of their acceptance status. Students who are accepted will be provided a link in ParentsWeb to complete online enrollment and pay the 10% tuition deposit (first of ten tuition payment installments). Once online enrollment is complete and the first month's tuition has been paid the student is officially enrolled.

STATEMENT OF FAITH
